Our School Council children recently handed out leaflets asking you help keep everyone safe as they are very worried about how dangerous it is when adults do not take their responsibility seriously.

We therefore ask again for you to use the school drop off and pick up opportunities to teach your children about road safety, encourage healthy minds and healthy bodies by parking a little further away from school and walking the rest together, and modelling respect and consideration for others to your children as they learn positive behaviour from you.
