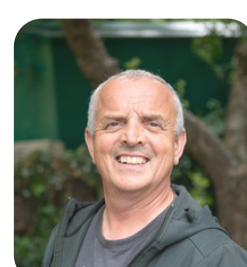

Raffle

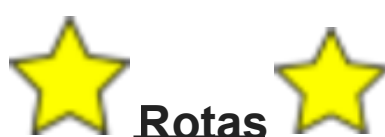
Raffle tickets are coming home this week in the children's bags selling at £1 each ticket. We have lots of fantastic prizes to be won!!!
